Throw = Course. — 30'0 stock rail = Rail contre-aiguille de 9.15 mètres — Point Guard = Armature de pointe. — 24'0 points and stock rail = Aiguille de 7.32 mètres et rail contre-aiguille. — Rail half size = 1/2 grandeur. — At toe of points : — A la pointe. — At 4'6 from toe = A 1.14 mètre de la pointe. — At 9'6 from toe = A 2.90 mètres de la pointe. — Half size section of 24'0 points = Coupe 1/2 grandeur de l'aiguille de 7.32 mètres.

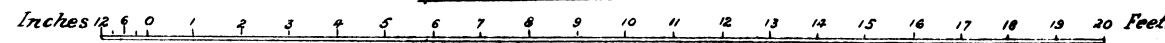
